A Letter from the Pastor

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Thanks to all who made the All Church Meeting on May 24 such an important and joyous occasion! We received with great thanks the Reports on the past year – and what a year it was! - from the Elected Leaders of First Church and members of the Pastoral Team, previously known as "the staff."

We elected, again with thanks, the Leaders who will serve us in the coming year. Please take a look at the "slate" included in this Herald (page 4). Note the strength of this diverse, committed, resourceful, and faithful group!

We approved the plan to replace the flat roof over the Jones Wing and update the HVAC for the Store! We also received the interim report from the Facilities Board on steps to be taken to provide adequate ventilation that will make the Sanctuary, Webb, and Eunoia Rooms safe and usable 12 months a year.

We voted unanimously to create a Co-Pastorate for The Reverend Vanessa Rose and myself, starting in September. I am thrilled personally by this decision and on behalf of the church I welcome this step that recognizes and honors Vanessa's significant vocational gifts and experience, and opens the door for her to exercise leadership in the full range of our congregation's life.
